With just 6 weeks from concept to delivery, ResinDriveways.co.uk produced 900 resin bound railway sleepers each measuring 1400mm x 300mm x 50mm to be installed in a 270m long pathway.

The pathway is an over-ground recreation of the historic Crab and Winkle Line. The original railway has the distinction of being the worlds first passenger railway tunnel, completed in 1826.

ResinDriveways.co.uk collaborated directly with The University of Kent and a well know architect firm to create this stunning celebration of the history of railway and the university.
